## 1) Go to http://www.citationmachine.net/apa/cite-a-journal Citation Machine" NEW My Papers Popular Styles Title Page Plagiarism Checker Writing Resources Contact Us a Chegg® service 2) Make sure "APA" is selected APA MLA Chicago More + for the style of the citation. 3) Make sure "Journal" Film Other Journal is selected if you are creating a citation for a journal article. Make sure your paper is error-free! NEW Try it now! 4) Select "Auto-fill Good job citing! Now get peace of mind. Scan your paper for Mode." grammar mistakes and catch unintentional plagiarism. 5) Copy/paste or type in Auto-fill mode Manual entry mode the Title of the journal article (e.g., "Nature "Nature and nurture in novelty seeking" Search Journal Articles and nurture in novelty seeking").

6) Click "Search Journal Articles."

7) You will now see a list of possible journal articles. Scroll down until you find the entry that matches the journal article you are citing. Once you find the entry that matches the journal article you are citing, click "Select."
