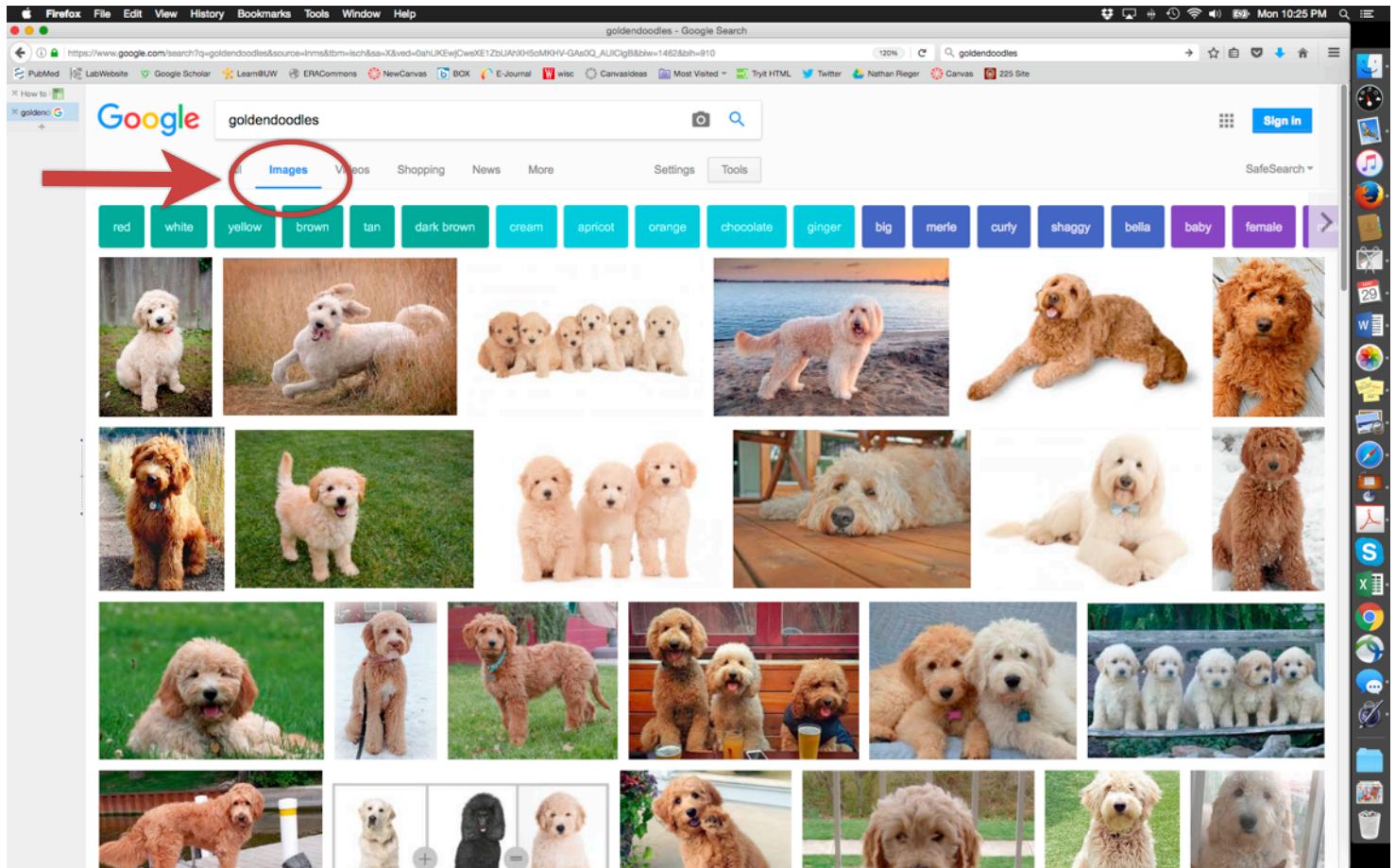
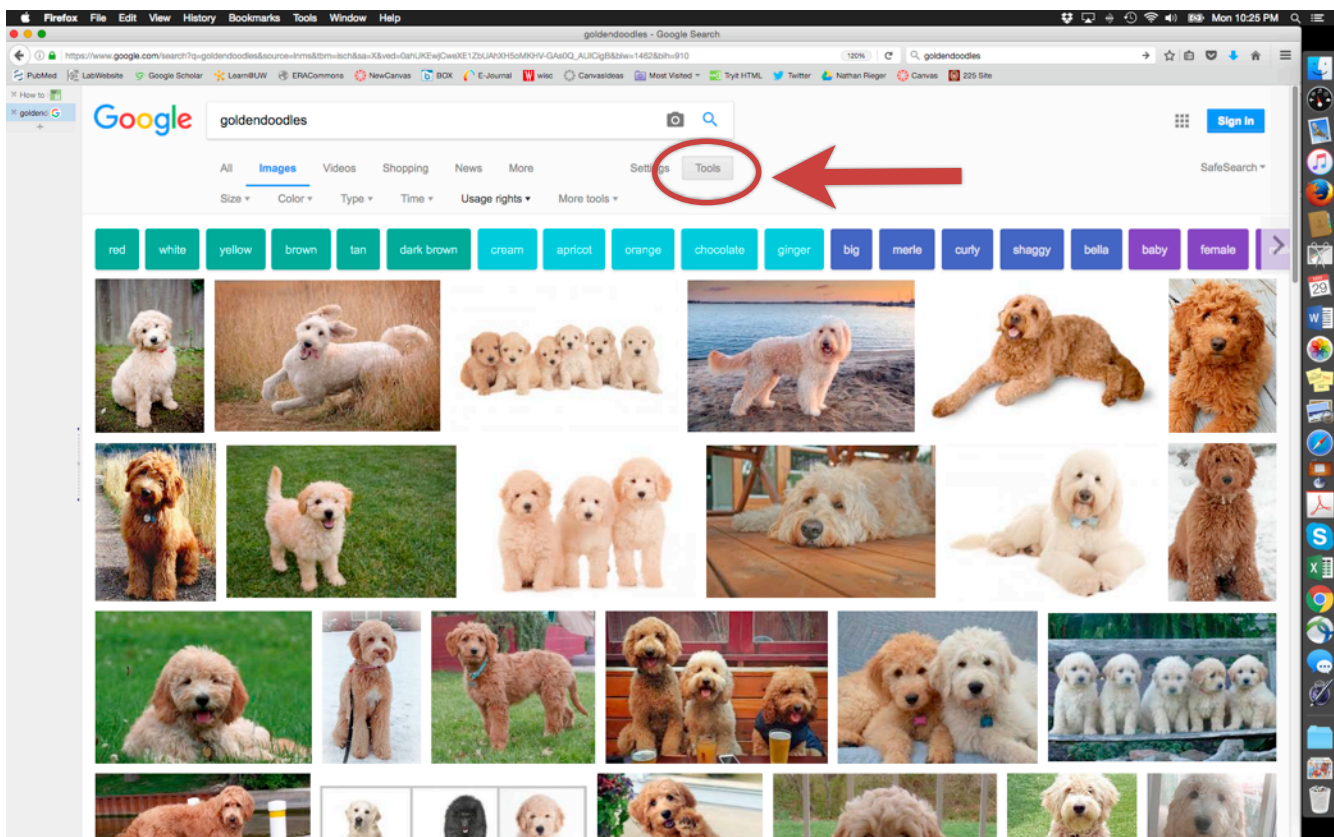


PSY 225 (Professor Gernsbacher): How to Use Google Image Search to Find Non-Copyrighted Images

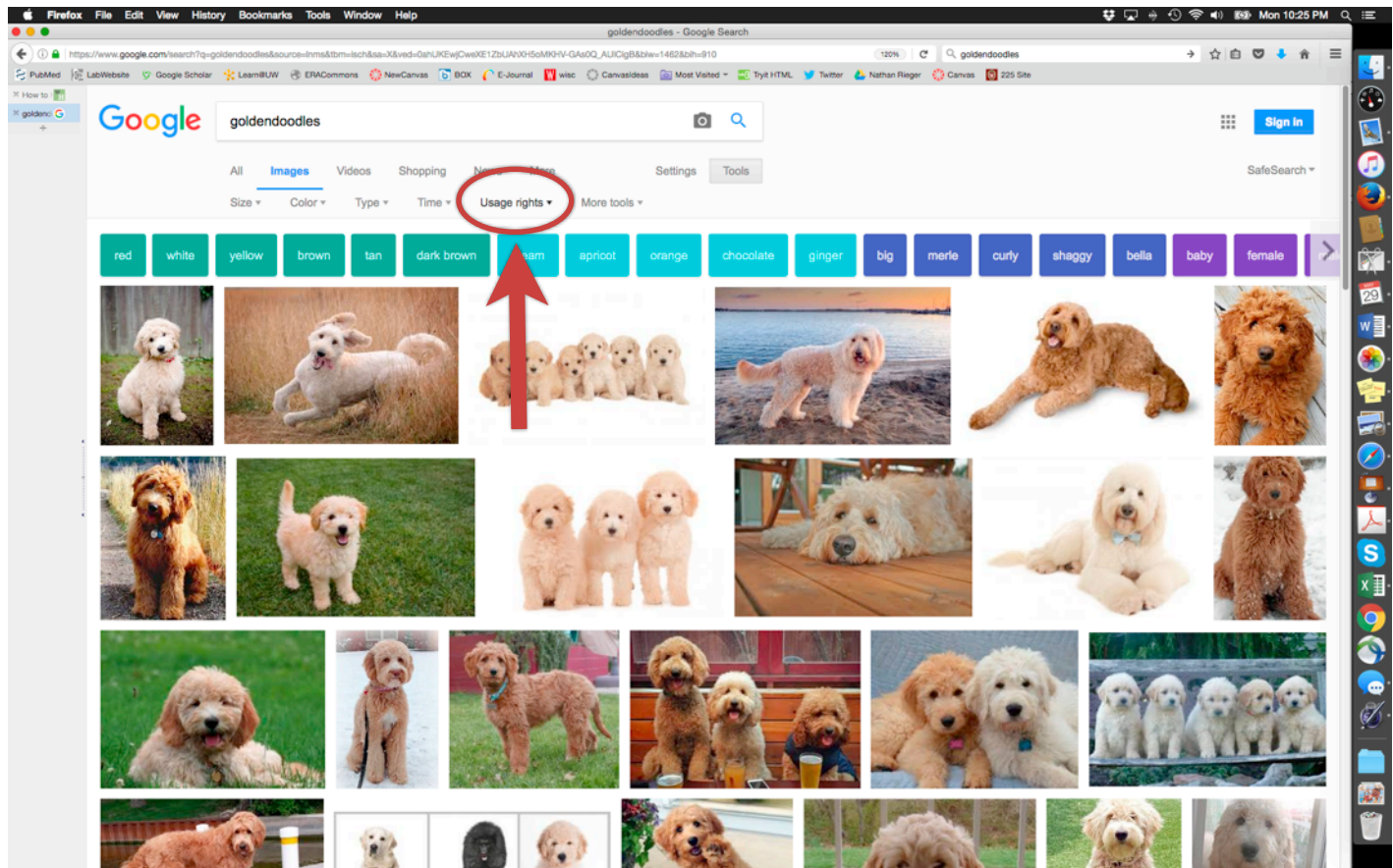
Go to Google. Type in a search word, such as goldendoodles. Click on the **Images** tab.



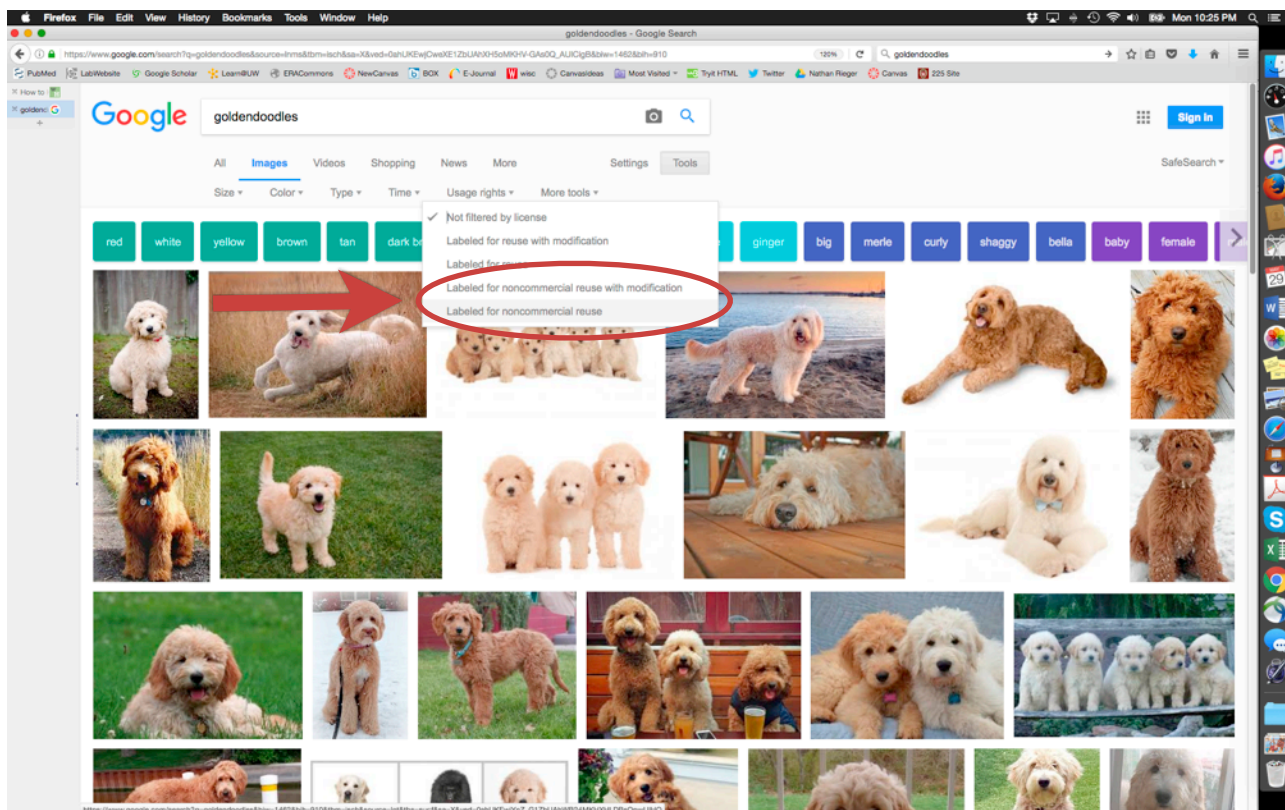
Then click on the **Tools** tab.



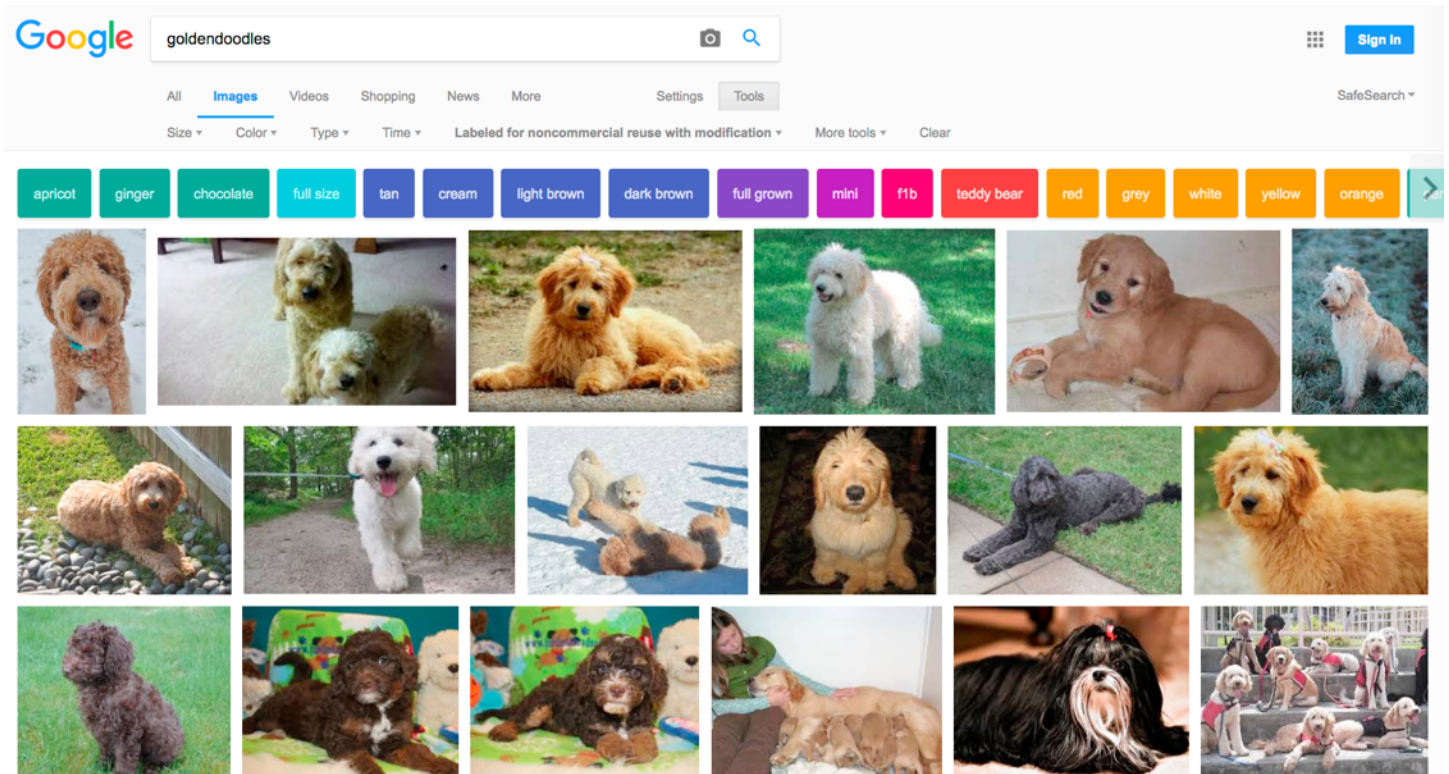
Then pull down the **Usage rights** menu.



Pull the Usage rights menu down to either **Labeled for non-commercial reuse** OR **Labeled for non-commercial reuse with modification** (if you plan to make any modifications to the image).



Now all the images that appear on the Google search results will be filtered for **non-commercial reuse OR for non-commercial reuse with modification** (if you that's the menu you selected).



However, to ensure that the image you want is available for non-commercial reuse AND to get the information you will need to provide an image credit, click on the image (from the search results)

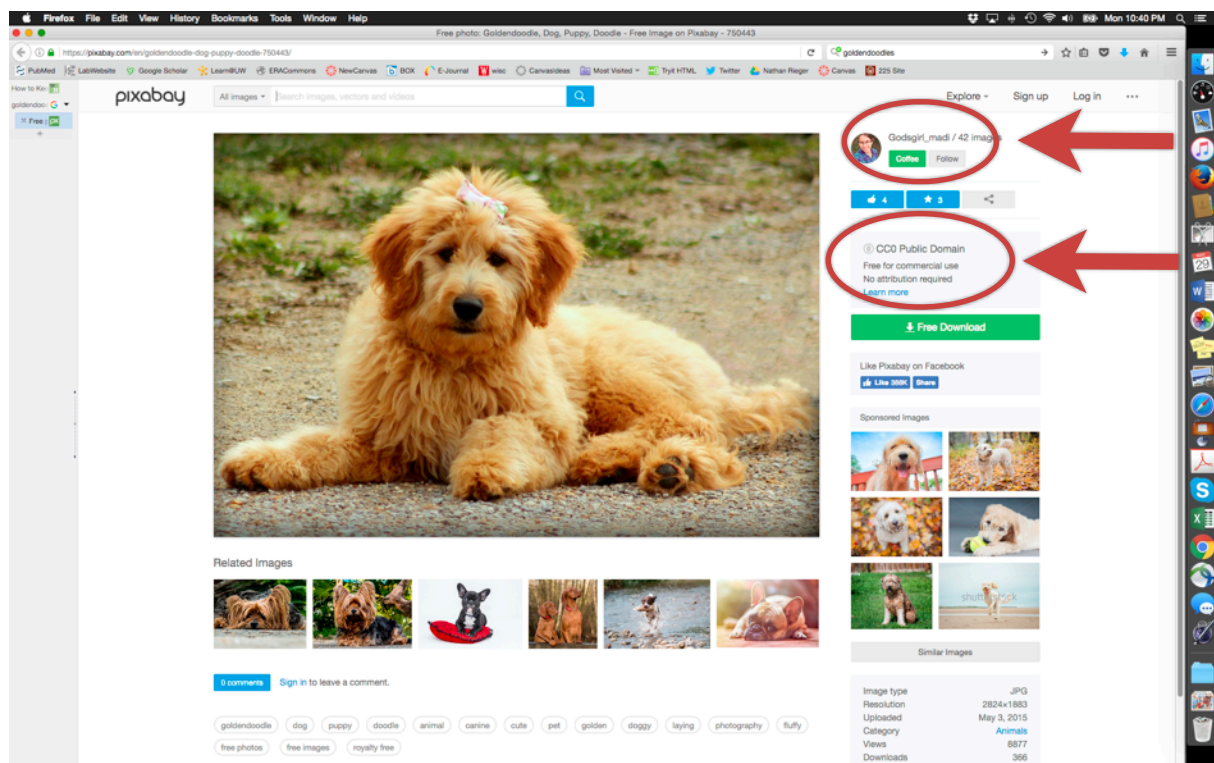
